Footnotes

ZUPPARDO ARDO drifted out at the start, fell far back in the early stages, trailed for a half, worked her way forward while saving ground nearing the quarter pole, closed the gap along the rail in upper stretch, eased out while rallying in deep stretch then outfinished FRENCH BRAIDS under steady left hand encouragement. FRENCH BRAIDS was unhurried early, gradually gained while four wide nearing the stretch then closed steadily under left hand urging to edge PROSPECTOR'S SONG for the place. PROSPECTOR'S SONG forced the pace from outside for a half, surged to the front approaching the top of the stretch, opened a clear lead in midstretch, continued on the front into deep stretch and yielded grudgingly. JILL'S LIL GIRL raced in the middle of the pack after breaking slowly, steadily gained along the inside to reach contention on the turn, raced within striking distance into upper stretch and finished evenly. HARPIA rushed up along the inside to gain the early advantage, set the pace under pressure for a half, surrendered the lead nearing the quarter pole and gradually tired thereafter. COLONIAL MINSTREL settled just off the early pace, angled between horses while three wide on the turn, made a run to threaten in upper stretch and flattened out. ANKLET raced in the middle of the pack for a half, drifted out on the turn, angled six wide entering the stretch and lacked a strong closing bid. DELTA MUSIC chased the leaders while four wide to the top of the stretch and gave way. RUBY SURPRISE was never a factor while six wide at the quarter pole.
