Footnotes

STARDUST BERTIE tracked the dueling leaders from early on, raced four wide, wrested the lead in the upper stretch and drew off under hand urging as much the best. VALID PULPIT, well placed in behind rivals into the stretch, swerved in and out while racing greenly at the eighth pole, angled four wide and earned second while no threat to STARDUST BERTIE. CHAMPAGNE PUNCH edged in early, raced in contention five or six wide and wasn't able to challenge while improving position. EMBLITTERATE battled for the lead from the beginning while outside of EMBLITTERATE, gained the front between calls nearing the stretch but faltered in the drive RED DICE, outrun into the stretch, improved position but couldn't menace. GOLDLEAFED MIRROR gained a slight advantage early while inside, dueled with EMBLITTERATE and weakened gradually leaving the turn. BEAUTIFUL TREASURE, hustled to gain a position early, moved in to race five wide, held on well until the stretch and weakened. FALL IN PLACE hopped at the start and wasn't a factor. TIME FOR A HEART was outrun. PASSING GRADE tired early. HAZY LADY broke a step slow, raced near the inside and was outrun.
