Footnotes

UNBRIDLED VISION, unhurried early and four wide, came a bit wider when rallying between foes into the final furlong, then responded to brisk left-handed urging to prevail. QUEST gained a forward position early but was seven wide on the backstretch, edged in a bit on the turn, moved steadily five wide to reach the front a quarter-mile out, then couldn't contain the winner's surge. MEDAL PLAY (ARG) gained the lead near the inside early, made the pace until the final quarter and grudgingly weakened. GOLD DOLLAR, reserved inside for five furlongs, came out five wide nearing the stretch, loomed a solid threat for the last eighth but failed to muster the needed response. HALO'S TIGER raced near the inside within striking distance to the stretch, eased out four wide for the rive but flattened out the last eighth. NANTUCKETEER, close up between rivals early, eased back to stalk the pace four until nearing the final quarter and weakened. BANANAS went up early to force the pace three abreast, edged in a bit to press front-running MEDAL PLAY (ARG) on the turn, held on well until approaching the stretch and faded. WOOSTERSHEAR, five or six wide throughout, never menaced. FADE ORACULO (ARG) gained a forward position early while edging near the inside, raced in contention for a half and weakened approaching the stretch.
