FINAL ROUND, lightly bumped at the start by LOVELY SAGE when that one leaned in, settled in hand near the inside, eased out three or four wide nearing the end of the backstretch, continued in that manner until the final quarter, came out five wide to rally, leaned in and brushed twice in the final furlong with FAST COOKIE and proved best under strong handling. LOVELY SAGE leaned in at the break bumping lightly with the winner, moved to the rail to race under rating, made a bold run into the stretch, came through close quarters in the final furlong and was second best in a good try. FAST COOKIE drifted out at the start, quickly recovered to track the leaders four or five wide, took over in the upper stretch, was brushed by the winner in the final furlong and weakened while swerving in and out a bit in the late going. REAL BEAR, well placed early, was checked in tight quarters between foes at the five-eighths pole, continued in contention behind rivals four wide into the lane and couldn't produce a late response. JUST BILL ME gained the advantage early, dueled with CROW JANE until the final quarter and faltered CROW JANE drifted out at the start, was straightened and sent up soon after to press the pace, stuck a head in front between calls leaving the turn but tired soon after.
