PROSPECTIVE SAINT stalked the pace slightly off the rail, closed the gap on the turn, angled outside the winner entering the stretch, accelerated to the front nearing the furlong marker then edged clear while being kept to the task. SHARI'S GOLD SOLE settled in good position while saving ground, lagged behind a bit on the turn, angled out at the top of the stretch then outfinished the pacesetter for the place. CEDAR SUMMER raced well back for a half after breaking a bit slowly, swung four wide entering the stretch then rallied belatedly in the middle of the track. LADY SABRINA sprinted clear soon after the start, raced uncontested on the lead into upper stretch then faltered in the final eighth. AUDREY HEP raced just off the pace in the two path to the top of the stretch and lacked a strong closing bid. SALINA'S GIFT never reached contention.
