 Older 123 lbs. Non-winners of \$200,000 at a mile or over since August 1 allowed 2 lbs.; \$100,000 at a mile or over since June 30, 4
 lbs.; \$50,000 twice at a mile or over in 2003-2004, 6 lbs.; \$50,000 at a mile or over in 2004, 8 lbs. If the race is moved to the main
 track after the time of closing, a horse may be scratched for any reason at any time up to 15 minutes prior to post time for the race
 preceding this race or thereafter with a valid physical reason and approved by the stewards. (If this race is taken off the turf it will be
 downgraded one grade level for this running only in accordance with the American Graded Stakes Committee Policy). Closed

Footnotes

STROLL closest to the pace while reserved, challenged from the three path with three furlongs to go, shook off SWEET RETURN inside the final furlong and drew clear under steady urging. SWEET RETURN (GB) sprinted clear, set a slow pace while off the hedge, responded willingly when challenged on the second turn, held on well to inside the final furlong, could not stay with the winner late and outfinished MYSTERY GIVER for the place. MYSTERY GIVER drifted out at the start tightening up outer rivals, was straightened to be forwardly placed between rivals, steadied once in the first turn when in tight, advanced three wide after six furlongs, split rivals in upper stretch, angled out with a furlong to go and rallied willingly. BURNING SUN forwardly placed off the inside, angled out four wide late on the second turn for clear room but lacked a late bid. HONOR IN WAR reserved off the inside, steadily entering the first turn when in tight, made a mild middle move off the hedge then lacked a closing bid. KICKEN KRIS bumped at the start, was in tight soon after when the winner came in a bit and MYSTERY GIVER drifted out, recovered to race within striking distance four wide but tired. EVERYTHING TO GAIN outran early, raced in the four path on the second turn and was no threat. SIR CHEROKEE bumped at the start and then steadied when MYSTERY GIVER drifted out, was outrun for six furlongs and rallied belatedly. STAGE CALL (IRE) forwardly placed four wide, faded in the final three furlongs. PERFECT SOUL (IRE) pulled a bit early along the inside when within striking distance, faded after a half. SKATE AWAY outrun, fell and lost his rider after six furlongs.
