STAKES Aegon Turf Sprint S. Grade 3 - Thoroughbred

FOR THREE-YEAR-OLDS AND UPWARD. By subscription of \$100 each, which should accompany the nomination or by Supplementary Nomination of \$5,000 at time of entry. \$500 to pass the entry box; \$500 additional to start, with \$100,000 added. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 62% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weights: Three year olds 118 lbs.; Older 124 lbs. Non-winners of \$45,000 twice on the turf since October 3 allowed 3 lbs.; \$45,000 on the turf in 2009, 6 lbs. Starters to be named through the entry box at the usual time of closing. Trophy to winning owner given by Aegon. (If this race is taken off of the turf it will be downgraded one grade level for this running only in accordance with American Graded Stakes Committee policy). Closed Wednesday, April 8, 2009 with 48 nominations. (If deemed inadvisable by management to run this race over the turf course, it will be run on the main track at Five Furlongs.)

Footnotes

CHAMBERLAIN BRIDGE bumped after the start by DUE DATE, recovered to be forwardly placed, came out four wide late on the turn and closed well to be up in time. CANNONBALL bumped at the start, recovered to race within striking distance four wide, angled a bit wider entering the stretch and closed well to miss. SMART ENOUGH allowed JAZZ NATION the advantage late on the backstretch, raced closest to that one thereafter while near the rail, challenged with a quarter mile to go, angled out for the drive after taking over and held on gamely while not quite good enough. DUE DATE bobbed at the start, bumped the winner recovering, was outrun early, came out six wide into the stretch and made a late gain on the outside. CAPTIVATING CAT forwardly placed off the inside, lacked the needed closing bid. CHITTOZ within striking distance, saved ground on the turn, moved closest to the pace with a furlong to go but hung late. JAZZ NATION sprinted clear, set the pace while kept out in the three path, held on well to the stretch and tired.
