After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 62% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weights: Three-year-olds 117 lbs.; Older 124 lbs. Non-winners of a Grade I or II stakes at a mile or over since September 1 allowed 2 lbs.; \$60,000 at a mile or over in 2009, 4 lbs.; \$45,000 twice at a mile or over in 2009, 6 lbs. Starters to be named through the entry box at the usual time of closing. Trophy to winning owner. Closed Wednesday, April 8, 2009 with 41 nominations.

Footnotes

BULLSBAY within striking distance along the inside, came off the rail and challenged in midstretch and proved best under pressure. COOL COAL MAN angled out off the rail on the first turn, raced closest to the pace thereafter, challenged with three furlongs to go, took over with a furlong to go, responded when joined by the winner soon after and held on gamely. STAR GUITAR forwardly placed three wide, moved out a ,path on the second turn, maintained good position to the final furlong but lacked a solid closing bid. INFORMED sprinted clear and angled in, set the pace near the rail and held on gamely. MAMBO IN SEATTLE within striking distance three wide, was in close quarters midway through the second turn and lacked a rally. MACHO AGAIN outrun for a half, commenced his rally in the five path with three furlongs to go and made a late gain. DR. PLEASURE close up while off the inside, raced under steady restraint on the backstretch, maintained a forward position to the stretch and tired. PROM SHOES outrun early, raced six wide into the stretch and could not threaten. SHIFT IN POWER broke slowly and was outrun.
