Footnotes

GALIENTOS pulled to the lead four wide, took over leaving the turn, shook clear and widened through the drive. MOE MAN was allowed to settle, came five wide to make a late rally and was along in time to earn the place. EASY TO PLEASE ME was forwardly placed along the inside, slipped through to make a mild bid but lacked the needed late response. SCARY GOOD vied for the lead between horses, was unable to match strides with the winner, drifted out entering the stretch and flattened in the final furlong. IMPERIAL PRIDE was allowed to settle, got through to make a mild gain but failed to seriously threaten. FOREST COAST broke in the air to get away behind his field, advanced between horses, angled in entering the stretch and improved position belatedly. IRISH EMPEROR was hustled along two wide in the second flight and failed to respond. DEETS disputed the pace along the inside, drifted out a bit leaving the turn, came up empty entering the stretch and faded. MR RUFF raced wide throughout and was never a factor. THUNDER HIGHWAY saved ground to no avail. ANGUS DRIVE broke slow, moved up three wide, but was through before going a half and dropped out.
