Footnotes

WISE DAN was reserved off of the pace along the outside, made a sweeping move five wide through the turn, reeled in MACJOEY inside the furlong marker and steadily edged clear. MACJOEY opened clear to dictate terms three wide, kept on well but was no match for the winner through the final furlong. GOOD LORD attended the pace off of the inside, got through entering the stretch but failed to improve his position through the drive. BRAVO WHISKEY broke a step slow, was unhurried into stride and tucked in to save ground, swung to the outside leaving the turn and was making up some ground late. DON'T PUT IT BACK chased the pace four wide to the stretch and weakened. VIA VERDE broke slowly, advanced between horses for a contending position, came three wide into the stretch but came up empty after five furlongs. HAVELOCK was away slowly, pulled between horses for a half and faltered. NEW PAIS was forwardly placed along the inside but was through before going a half and retreated.
