MAJOR MARVEL attended the pace along the inside, angled out to make his bid mid way through the second turn, assumed command and quickly drew clear. GAME BALL was unhurried into stride, swung to the outside to make a late rally, finished well and clearly proved second best. CASEY'S IMAGE settled saving ground, got through and was along in time to earn the show. WHATTHECATDRUGIN opened clear and angled in to set the pace, faltered entering the stretch and gave way. ALMIGHTY ADVERSARY settled four wide and lacked a response when called upon. AL BASHA tucked in to save ground, shifted out to make a mild bid leaving the second turn but failed to sustain the drive. TUTTI BUONA GENTE tracked three wide, went wrong leaving the second turn, was pulled up entering the stretch and was vanned off.
