Footnotes

EYES ON EDDY, reserved early and four wide on the backstretch, was put to a drive three furlongs out, swung six wide into the stretch, then closed determinedly under left-handed whipping to wear down SUGAR SWIRL in the going. SUGAR SWIRL forced the pace in hand early, took over before going a half, moved clear, came out a bit farther on the track for the drive and had no mishap while unable to last. STADORE (FR) raced within easy striking distance four or five wide into the final furlong and came up empty. SACRED FEATHER, up close along the inside early, raced in forwardly to the stretch and flattened out when asked. ELLA BELLE gained a slim led early while between foes and tired after three-quarters. TEN CARAT RUBY settled near the inside, swung out five or six wide leaving the turn and never fired.
