DANCING FOREVER settled in hand three or four wide while closer than usual behind modest fractions, began to edge closer three furlongs out, collared front-running NIAGARA CAUSEWAY in the final sixteenth and wore him down under pressure. NIAGARA CAUSEWAY bobbed while breaking sluggishly, quickly recovered to press front-running FOSTER in hand, inched to the front approaching the final quarter, opened a clear advantage but could not contain the winner's surge. FAITH'S MAGIC, well placed under a rating hold along the inside, was asked between foes upon entering the upper stretch but lacked the needed response. MALAMEEZE, lightly rated three wide, couldn't threaten in the late going when asked. FOSTER gained the advantage at the start, angled near the inside, made the pace to the head of the stretch and faltered. EL CHILE DOG always was outrun.
