STAKES Woodford Reserve Turf Classic S. Grade 1 - Thoroughbred

FOR THREE-YEAR-OLDS AND UPWARD. By subscription of \$100 each on or before February 14, 2009 or by Supplementary Nomination of \$25,000 each at the time of entry. \$2,500 to pass the entry box; \$2,500 additional to start with \$500,000 added. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 62% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Three-year-olds 117 lbs. Older 124 lbs. Non-winners of a Gradeor Group 1 stakes over a mile on the turf since October 3, 2008 allowed 3 lbs.; \$150,000 over a mile on the turf since September 1, 2008, 5 lbs.; a graded or group stakes at a mile or over in 2008-2009, 7 lbs. Starters to be named through the entry box Wednesday, April 29, 2009 at the usual time of closing. Trophy to winning owner given by Woodford Reserve. (If this race is taken off the turf it will be downgraded one grade level for this running only in accordance with the American Graded Stakes Committee policy). Closed Saturday, February 14, 2009 with 101 nominations. (If deemed inadvisable by management to run this race over the turf course, it will be run on the main track at One and One Eighth mile.).

Footnotes

EINSTEIN (BRZ) rated while within easy striking distance and off the inside, moved well out on the course on the backstretch, angled back in to split rivals with three furlongs to go, was fanned six wide entering the stretch, challenged in upper stretch and proved narrowly best under pressure. COWBOY CAL closest to the pace, moved well out in the strip on the backstretch, made a five wide run to challenge near the quarter mile marker, gained a short lead in midstretch, battled to the final sixteenth and weakened. COURT VISION outrun early while off the inside, angled out entering the stretch when making a good move but could not sustain the bid. ZAMBEZI SUN (GB) sluggish at the start, quickly gained a good position, was fanned seven wide entering the stretch and weakened. THORN SONG broke a bit flat footed, showed good speed to quickly move clear, angled well out in the course on the backstretch, angled back in into the turn, came four wide into the stretch and weakened. PROUDINSKY (GER) forwardly placed near the inside, moved off the rail for the second turn, made a run to challenge in midstretch but weakened late. EL CABALLO unhurried early, raced three wide with three furlongs to go, angled out six wide approaching the stretch when making a mile bid but had little left late. FURTHEST LAND within striking distance, made a mild four wide move into the second turn, was fanned seven wide into the stretch and lacked a rally. YATE'S BLACK CAT unhurried while outrun, made a five wide middle move,

came eight wide into the stretch and could not menace.
