LUSTER set the pace from the rail position, led the field throughout and was ridden out in the lane. HONCHIS'N PONCHIS was well back in the early stages, made a run four wide out of the turn but was no match for the winner. GIRLS IMAGE saved ground in the opening half while never far back, had a mild run on the turn while racing inside but flattened out late. LACIE SLEW was taken up shortly after the start, rated in the opening half then lacked the needed response. EAST BREAKS raced three wide on the turn while forwardly placed, made a bid on the outside then faded late. KNOCKOUT BERTIE raced close up early while on the inside then tired in the turn. PEARL OF VALOR trailed and was not a factor. PASSION DU COEUR stalked the pace from the outside then gave way on the turn.
