**Footnotes**

GLENWOOD CANYON rated close up while racing inside, eased out leaving the far turn, moved two wide under some hand urging past the three eighths pole, took command nearing the lane, dueled briefly in upper stretch, responded to strong left handed urging and steadily drew away. NORTHERN PRINCE disputed the early pace along the rail, moved clear nearing the five eighths pole, was joined by the winner after six furlongs, battled inside that one to mid stretch, weakened a bit but was well clear for the place. A. U. MINER settled back early while saving ground, angled out four wide for the drive and had a belated response. BROTHER KEITH broke in the air, lost ground five wide around the first turn, chased the pace off the rail to the far turn then gave way. ZIEGFELD stalked the pace between rivals and tired. MAGENTA LIGHT (AUS) , bumped then pinched back at the break, raced well back and was four wide in upper stretch. BULL TOCCET broke outward and bumped MAGENTA LIGHT (AUS), lost ground five wide nearing the far turn and failed to menace. LEOPOLD BLOOM dueled early three wide, chased the leader four wide into the far turn and faltered. TIP TOP H. A. T. , three to five wide chasing the pace, faltered.
