Footnotes

FLYING METRO tracked the leaders from early on while four wide, gained a slight edge leaving the furlong grounds, then was all out to hold off EXCELLENT LUCK. The latter, jolted and forced in on DANZOR LAD at the start, was outrun for a half, came out nine or 10 wide for the drive and closed well. POLISHED BRASS, never far back, raced in behind the leaders for a half, came out five wide for the drive and finished willingly. GAMBLE LES broke the stall doors open prior to the start and alertly was snared by the assistant starter. During the running, GAMBLER LES gained the lead early, edged inward, made the pace into the final furlong and weakened. RED RANGER worked his way inward by the turn, rallied six wide into the stretch, loomed a solid threat for the last eighth but came up empty. INGENIUS, forwardly placed along the inside into the stretch, flattened out late. CATNIRO saved ground but failed to menace. SPECULATION tired upon going a half. BOONESVILLE ducked in at the start jolting EXCELLENT LUCK, raced in contention five wide for a half and tired. DANZOR LAD, sluggish to start and squeezed back, was wide on the backstretch and 10 wide in the stretch. BROWN EYED MAJOR unseated the rider while breaking through the gate prior to the start and ran off for a sixteenth before being captured. During the running, BROWN EYED MAJOR had brief speed, gave way and wasn't persevered with when hopelessly beaten.
