Footnotes

SUGAR BABE, in hand inside early, eased out four wide nearing the end of the backstretch, alternated for the advantage approaching the stretch, reached the front for good in the upper stretch, then proved gamely best under strong handling. MAESTRO, never far back while four wide,moved with the winner while outside that one approaching the stretch, had clear aim and was outgamed. A. P. FIVE HUNDRED, within easy striking distance while five or six wide, ranged up outside the leaders for the final furlong and was steadily gaining. STERLING GOLD, bumped at the start, settled in hand inside, saved ground for six furlongs, came out five wide for the drive, then flattened out the last eighth. ELEGANT PERFORMER, outrun for a half, raced near the inside on the far turn, angled four wide into the stretch but failed to gain in the last eighth. DEVIL'S DANDY went up early to press front-running MOLINO ROJO, gained a slight edge upon going a half, held on well for six furlongs and faded. SEATTLE SANTA hopped at the start, raced five wide and failed to menace. MOLINO ROJO gained the advantage inside early, made the pace for almost a half and tired. LIKE THE WIND drifted in at the start bumping STERLING GOLD, was steadied in tight quarters approaching the first turn, then never menaced. UNREAL was finished early.
