Footnotes

DIXIE VELVET settled near the inside early, moved between rivals approaching the stretch, was checked for a stride at the three-sixteenths pole when seeking room between foes, split the leaders three wide soon after, took over and edged clear under brisk urging. SYNERGISTIC, never far back while following the the leaders four wide, reached the front between calls approaching the stretch, then couldn't race with DIXIE VELVET in the final furlong as second best. FLIPETTE, unhurried early, raced behind horses, came out five or six wide approaching the stretch, loomed a solid threat but couldn't muster the needed response. CRAZYBOUTAMERCURY, rated near the inside early, advanced between foes on the second turn, came out five or six wide for the drive but was empty the last eighth. LIB came out at the start and bumped FLYING MARLIN, went up soon after to to press pacesetting BROOK BY THE SEA, took over soon after going a half, held on well for six furlongs and weakened thereafter. FLYING MARLIN, bumped at the break but within easy striking distance while between foes three or four wide much of the way, flattened out entering the stretch. PRINCEAPECIA saved ground throughout but faded approaching the stretch. SLEW STREET, six or seven wide around the first turn, never menaced. BROOK BY THE SEA moved to the fore inside early, made the pace until the end of the backstretch, surrendered the advantage to LIB soon after, gave way and was eased.
