Footnotes

TESTIFY, outprinted early and four wide on the backstretch, eased out seven or eight wide to secure a clear path leaving the turn, then closed determinedly under pressure to wear down TEXAS GLITTER. The latter, a bit difficult to load into the gate, gained a forward position near the inside, rallied from the rail, reached the front just after the stretch call, then couldn't contain TESTIFY in the closing yards. GONE FISHIN, outrun early while racing three wide, came out to rally from between rivals four or five wide into the final furlong and was going well at the end. MIGHTY BEAU gained the lead soon after the start, moved near the inside while dueling with ORIENTATE and MORLUC, shook them off entering the stretch, then weakened the final sixteenth while exchanging brushes late with MORLUC and ORIENTATE. MORLUC maneuvered in soon after the start to force the issue three abreast, raced close up into the final furlong and was unable to muster a final response while leaning in and brushing with MIGHTY BEAU. FREEWAY TICKET, within striking distance but four or five wide, was with the winner while inside that one in the upper stretch but failed to sustain a closing account. RED LIGHTNING, within striking distance while racing in behind foes three wide early, moved down next to the hedge for the drive but was empty the last eighth. GRANGEVILLE, outrun inside until the stretch, came out nine or 10 wide for the final sixteenth but never menaced. ORIENTATE worked his way inward early to contest the pace, battled between MIGHTY BEAU and MORLUC, held on well until the final furlong and weakened while exchanging brushes with MIGHTY BEAU. GOLDEN DRAGON (GB) drifted out slightly at the start, raced seven or eight wide on the backstretch, remained off the inside and was nine or 10 wide in the stretch run while never a factor.
