### Footnotes

SPAIN, carefully handled from the beginning, went up to force the pace from between foes, edged to the front just prior to going six furlongs, expanded her advantage a bit, turned back an earnest challenge from MYSTIC LADY approaching the sixteenth pole and was under brisk urging the remainder. MYSTIC LADY, lightly rated early while tracking the leaders four wide, made a threatening five-wide run leaving the furlong grounds but failed to sustain the needed momentum as second best. DE BERTIE, racing in a right-front bar shoe, was outrun until the stretch while three wide, moved out five wide for the stretch run and offered a mild gain. MALTESE SUPERB, never far back, moved up three abreast, although five wide on the backstretch, reached the front briefly entering the second turn, lost the edge to SPAIN soon after, then gradually weakened in the drive. FOREST SECRETS gained the advantage early, raced in the three path, was engaged on the backstretch by SPAIN and MALTESE SUPERB, lost the lead leaving the backstretch, continued prominently for six furlongs and weakened. RED N'GOLD, four or five wide early, moved to the rail on the first turn, edged closer approaching the stretch, eased out three wide, angled back to the rail when straightened for the drive but flattened out.
