Footnotes

FARDA AMIGA, bumped lightly at the start by HABIBTI when that one drifted in, settled in hand near the inside while appearing to be climbing on the first turn, eased out five wide approaching the end of the backstretch to commence her rally, reached the leaders a quarter-mile out, leaned in slightly tightening it up for a stride on HABIBTI, was soundly shaken up with the whip left-handed soon after, caught front-running TAKE CHARGE LADY a sixteenth out, then, under strong handling, edged clear late. TAKE CHARGE LADY drifted in at the start and bumped soon after with ART FAIR, continued inside to gain the lead, went along under careful handling, turned back a challenge from YOU approaching the five-sixteenths pole, managed a clear advantage into the final furlong, then couldn't contain FARDA AMIGA in the final sixteenth. HABIBTI drifted in at the break and bumped the winner, was never far back while rated between horses four wide, edged closer nearing the stretch, was checked for a stride at the three-sixteenths when the winner leaned in, was angled outside FARDA AMIGA soon after and couldn't muster the needed response. YOU, within easy striking distance while stalking TAKE CHARGE LADY three or four wide, went after her leaving the three-eighths pole, continued forwardly into the upper stretch and couldn't keep pace. TAKE THE CAKE, steadied sharply off TAKE CHARGE LADY'S heels approaching the first turn while near the inside, settled soon after while two or three wide, raced within easy striking distance into the stretch while continuing inside, then flattened out. ILE DE FRANCE worked her way inward early to press the pace, raced between TAKE CHARGE LADY and YOU, held on well for nearly six furlongs and gradually weakened. MS BROOKSKI came out at the start and jolted IMPERIAL GESTURE, raced four or five wide early, moved to the inside on the backstretch and was finished upon going six furlongs. IMPERIAL GESTURE, slammed from both sides at the start and pinched back, quickly settled to follow the leaders in a striking position five or six wide, made a run from that point on the track midway on the far turn, then faltered when straightened for the drive. After pulling up past the wire, the rider of IMPERIAL GESTURE dismounted and walked her back to be unsaddled. ART FAIR broke in on IMPERIAL GESTURE at the start, came out soon after bumping with TAKE CHARGE LADY, then was outrun. A foul claim by the rider of HABIBTI against the winner for alleged interference in the upper stretch was disallowed.
