Footnotes

ADMIRALITY raced close up while three wide to the quarter pole, ranged up on the leaders turning for home and was roused hard while drifting to edge clear at the furlong marker then held on under steady urging. MAMBO IN SEATTLE raced in good position from near inside to the final turn, angled out for the drive and closed well through the final stages while erratic in the closing furlong. LEMON CUSTARD well off the rail throughout, rallied around the turn with a mild late gain in the lane. MAPMAKER vied for the lead from inside with SONOMA CAT, stayed well to deep stretch and faltered in the late going. SONOMA CAT dueled with MAPMAKER from the two path, gained a short lead into the stretch but could not go on and weakened in the final furlong. NORTHERN VOW forwardly placed for a half, failed to respond when needed and gave way thereafter. CHIEF GONE WEST never menaced. RED SANDY trailed most of the way and only passed one late while widest in the stretch. MANAGER BOIRE had a three wide trip, made a mild middle move but flattened out from the quarter pole.
