### Footnotes

CHEROKEE ARTIST forwardly placed four wide, moved in a bit after a half, challenged three wide on the second turn, shook off SCIBELLI inside the final furlong and drew clear late. SCIBELLI alternated for the lead from the start three wide, moved in a path on the second turn, responded willingly when challenged by the winner and held on gamely in the stretch to save the place. YOU AND I FOREVER within striking distance three wide, followed the winner after five furlongs but lacked a closing bid. A DIEHL alternated for the lead along the inside, held on well to the stretch and tired. BK'S CLEARANCEISLE reserved along the inside, angled out and made a mild gain on the second turn, came four wide into the stretch but could not threaten. CAJUN PRIZE forwardly placed off the inside, gave way the final quarter. WHYWHY CAT bumped entering the first turn when wide, made a mild three wide gain on the second turn but could not menace. RUNAWAY BANJO angled in to save ground on the first turn, moved off the rail for the second turn and was no factor. CHRIS GOT EVEN clipped heels and bobbed after the start and was outrun. GRAND TURK swerved out entering the first turn, steadied bumping WHYWHY CAT then was outrun and eased up late. SCREEN TO SCREEN forwardly placed along the inside, stopped and was eased up late.
