BEIJOCA broke a step slow, settled in hand, circled five wide to make her bid, reeled in the leader nearing the furlong marker and kicked clear. TELLER TERRI stumbled badly at the start, was unhurried into stride, swung to the outside entering the stretch and finished well to earn the place. GOTTAHAVEADREAM stalked the pace three wide, assumed command mid way through the second turn, opened clear but faltered during the drive and settled for the show. KAYS BIRTHDAY tucked in to save ground, angled out after six furlongs and improved position. MISS BETTY P chased three wide through the second turn and tired. BELLA BANDITA settled between horses but lacked a response when called upon. INDIAN MIRACLE was rank to place early, settled four wide and failed to respond. PICK ME pulled to contention four wide, but came up empty on the second turn and faded. BEAR ON THE RUN set the pressured pace along the inside for six furlongs and stopped. SHARON SHOOKLEE saved ground to no avail.
