BAREFOOT BANDIT pressed the pace four wide, challenged on the turn, responded in the stretch and had to be fully extended to gain the decision. MANLY vied for the lead three wide and held on stubbornly but was outfinished. MUCHO MACHO UNO behind the leaders off the inside, angled out for the drive but lacked a rally. GRAND IDOL forced the pace between rivals, stayed on well to the stretch and tired. SPEIGHT ME outrun early, raced in the three path on the turn and was no threat. IN JEOPARDY vied for the lead along the inside and faded.
