SWAKOPMUND behind the leaders four wide, challenged from the three path on the second turn and drew clear under steady urging. SUMMER KITTEN outrun early off the rail, moved out to be five wide midway through the second turn when rallying but lodged only a mild bid for the place. AVA'S PLAYFUL RUN alternated for the lead three wide, moved in a path on the second turn, held on well to inside the final furlong and tired. CANDY STORE KID close up along the inside, tired in the drive. SAVANNAH'S GLORY forced the pace off the inside, moved out to be in the four path on the second turn and tired. ALEGRA vied for the lead along the inside and faded. LEMON TIZ within striking distance off the inside, tired. SOUTHERN VELVET was outrun.
