PROFETIZA sprinted clear and angled in, set the pace near the rail and lasted late. PLENTY O'TOOLE within striking distance three wide, angled out for the drive and rallied willingly but missed. KANSAS stumbled at the start, recovered to race within reach, was in the two path on the second turn and lodged a mild late bid. ADVENTURE AT SEA forwardly placed three wide, stayed on well to the stretch and tired. CORA MESA outsprinted early four wide, made a five wide run on the second turn but could not sustain the bid. ALLEGHENY ANGEL eager early when reserved, showed late interest. GUNNER GAL outrun to the stretch, rallied belatedly. DIXIE FICTION closest to the pace off the inside, held on well to the final quarter and tired. CINDY SAYS six wide midway through the second turn when making a mild gain, was no factor in the stretch. HEAVEN'S SAINT forwardly placed along the inside, stopped.
