### Footnotes

GOLIGHTLY, never far back, worked her in by the turn, saved ground until the stretch, angled out four wide to rally, took over, edged clear and was kept to strong handling. SILK SAILS drifted out at the start bumping THE HESS EXPRESS, was outrun for a half, made a run four or five wide into the final furlong, was just off the winner but couldn't muster the needed response. THE HESS EXPRESS, bumped at the start, was outsprinted early, saved ground, came out to make a run five wide approaching the upper stretch, loomed a solid threat but failed to sustain the needed momentum. CHASE ISLAND, sluggish to begin, was hustled along the inside to vie for the lead, gained a slim advantage on the turn, held on well until the stretch while dueling inside of WICHITIZ and weakened thereafter. WICHITIZ moved a slight edge early, lost it to CHASE ISLAND from the inside on the turn, held on well until the stretch and tired. DOE NA WANE, outrun early, saved ground throughout but failed to seriously menace. LAUNCH A DOUBLE drifted out at the start, tracked the early pace four wide and tired. BLUE DIAMOND RUN vied for the lead early while three abreast and tired.
