Footnotes

DON'T FRET, reserved at once and angled near the rail, continued inside while advancing around the far turn and into the lane, eased out three or four wide about the three-sixteenths pole, then responded to urging and edged clear late. TRUE COMPETITOR, always well placed and between foes three or four wide, loomed menacingly for the drive but couldn't match strides with DON'T FRET in the last eighth. PENNANT CONTENDER gained the lead near the inside early, repelled a challenge from OLYMPIC approaching the lane, showed the way into the last eighth and weakened late. ROMAN'S RUN, never far back and four or five wide, failed to muster a late response. PAVAROTTI, outrun five wide to the stretch, improved position but wasn't a threat. BEST YEARS, within easy striking distance while in behind the leaders three or four wide, was empty leaving the second turn. IFONLYJOHNNY passed tired horses. SHONE settled between foes three or four wide on the first turn, was asked for his best a quarter-mile out but failed to respond. OLYMPIC was used early to gain a forward position three or four wide, offered an earnest challenge nearing the final quarter but failed to continue. INSTANT MESSENGER weakened leaving the second turn. PROSPECT BEGONIA chased the pace from between foes three or four wide and faded on the far turn.
