Footnotes

TORA stalked the dueling leaders from early on while three or four wide, took over about the sixteenth pole, then was fully extended to hold sway. GEM SLEUTH, never far back and near the inside, was three wide and steadied behind horses at the five-sixteenths pole, angled five wide for the drive and was going well at the end. FEATHERBED gained a slim lead inside early, dueled with THRU N' THRU, lost the edge to that one nearing the lane, recaptured the lead at the furlong pole but weakened soon after. MEREDITH BEE settled in behind horses four wide, came a bit wider into the lane and managed a mild gain. ANGELS' SHARE, outrun for a half, rallied inside through the upper stretch, angled four wide very late and improved position. THRU N' THRU broke sharply to vie for the lead at one while outside of FEATHERBED, gained the advantage concluding the turn, lost the edge back to that rival at the furlong grounds and weakened. EARLY VINTAGE broke in the air, was outrun early, moved up along the inside nearing the stretch but couldn't sustain his effort. LADY TAKUM, outrun to the lane, never reached serious contention. GRAEME SIX, never far back, exchanged bumps with BEYOND INFINITY at the seven-sixteenths pole and weakened in the drive. LILLY CARSON, five or six wide, was finished approaching the stretch. BEYOND INFINITY, jolted at the start by GRECOURT GATES, exchanged bumps with GRAEME SIX at the seven-sixteenths pole and was finished after a half. GRECOURT GATES ducked out at the start jolting BEYOND INFINITY and never was a factor.
