Footnotes

DUVEEN went up early to press front-running JAZZ QUEST under light rating three or four wide, inched to the fore in the upper stretch, then was hard ridden to hold sway. WHATSTHESCRIP (IRE), in hand while between foes three wide from early on, was steadied for a stride or two leaving the half-mile ground, worked his way out five wide for the drive and was going well at the end. JAZZ QUEST moved to the fore inside early, went along under careful handling, made the pace into the upper stretch and weakened. MARCAVELLY, always prominent tracking the pace four wide, loomed a solid threat for the final furlong but failed to fire. DISTORTED REALITY, within striking distance and four or five wide most of the trip, lacked a closing punch. TOP CROSS settled three wide, continued near the inside into the final furlong and couldn't make a significant impact. BIRDBIRDISTHEWORD, never far back and five or six wide, made a bold run six wide at the quarter-mile ground but flattened out when straightened for the drive. ROYAL WAR ACADEMY raced near the inside most of the way and weakened. DELIGHTFUL KISS, always off the inside, never menaced. COBRADOR, sluggish to start, settled three wide, swung out ten wide for the drive and couldn't offer a closing kick.
