SILVER MAX sprinted clear and angled in, set the pace while in the three path on the first turn, moved in a bit after a half, managed a comfortable advantage into the stretch and stayed clear under steady urging. TRAVEL ADVISORY unhurried for a half three wide, moved in a bit on the backstretch, was patiently handled around the second turn, angled out for the drive and finished willingly to be up for the place. HOWE GREAT hit the side of the starting gate stall at the start, was reserved early, made a four wide run on the second turn but lodged only a mild late bid. FINNEGANS WAKE angled in when outrun early, lagged well back for six furlongs, steadied and swerved wide approaching the stretch to avoid a fallen rider then finished willingly on the outside. LOOK AT THE TIME within striking distance off the inside, moved out a path on the second turn, maintained his position into the final furlong but lacked a late bid. COALPORT close up while off the inside, reached closest to the winner near the rail on the second turn but weakened in the drive. GUNG HO within striking distance near the rail, saved ground on the second turn and lacked a late bid. TONES (IRE) within striking distance four wide, raced in the three path on the second turn and had nothing left late. BLUESKIESRAINBOWS close up along the inside, held on well to the stretch and gave way. SCATMAN forwardly placed three wide, tracked the leaders into the stretch and tired. FLASHY DRESSER outrun for a half, steadied and swerved out approaching the stretch then could not menace. SILVER MENACE reared at the start, trailed for six furlongs, swerved wide approaching the stretch and could not men ace. STAR CHANNEL awkward at the start, raced within reach early, swerved out and then in approaching the stretch unseating his rider.
