Footnotes

FRAZEE'S FOLLY, able to gain a forward position early while working his way inside, rallied four wide on the second turn to take over, then drew off through the final furlong under intermittent urging. COLONEL HARLAN lunged out at the start to trail, moved inside, saved ground to the far turn, came out to make a run six wide nearing the stretch and wasn't a threat in the drive while outgaming LINDSAY'S LEGACY. The latter, never far back, also worked his way inward, followed the winner five wide on the second turn, loomed menacingly in the upper stretch, commenced lugging in and weakened. CAREFREE, a bit slow to start, saved ground in hand, was unhurried for six furlongs and not a threat while improving position. FESTIVAL OF LIGHT, checked in behind horses approaching the first turn, made a run from between foes three wide nearing the stretch but flattened out when straightened for the drive. YOU'RE A GOOD MAN, outrun while saving ground for six furlongs, failed to reach contention. COLORADO DRIVE made a mild bid to reach contention on the second turn but failed to continue. SHELBY LANE close up inside from the start, moved to challenge INDY FEVER for the lead on the backstretch, gained a slight edge but was finished before going six furlongs. INDY FEVER made the pace for nearly a half and tired. DOMINUS went up early to force the pace three wide but was finished by the end of the backstretch. GIN DIAMOND was never prominent.
