Footnotes

DREAM SUPREME, in hand early, raced three or four wide while tracking front-running LA FEMINN, inched after that one in the upper stretch, reached the front leaving the furlong grounds and was under mild urging to prevail. LA FEMINN drifted out soon after the start, was straightened while while sprinting clear, was taken in hand, raced a bit off the inside and made the pace into the final furlong. At that point, the the rider dropped his whip, removed his helmet cover offering left-handed encouragement, but LA FEMINN couldn't handle DREAM SUPREME. NANY'S SWEEP bobbled at the start, saved ground until the final quarter, swung out seven or eight wide for the drive and offered a mild gain. THE HAPPY HOPPER, outsprinted early, saved ground, made a run from the inside nearing the stretch to reach easy striking distance but failed to sustain the needed acceleration. ANOTHER drifted out after the start, drifted out once again when leaving the chute, raced forwardly until approaching the stretch and tired.
