Footnotes

WHITE HEART (GB), reserved inside early, eased out to track the leaders four wide on the backstretch, advanced from that position on the course into the stretch, reached the front, then, while drifting out a bit in the late stages, gamely held KING CUGAT safe under strong handling. KING CUGAT hopped a bit at the start while breaking sluggishly, was taken inside, raced in hand, moved out six wide on the backstretch, came out a bit farther on the course for the drive, had aim at the winner and wasn't good enough. BRAHMS moved in behind foes early, raced under light rating three or four wide, came out a bit on the course on the second turn, moved with the winner while outside that one, loomed a solid threat for the final furlong and was checked in tight quarters leaving the sixteenth pole when WHITE HEART (GB) came out slightly. THESAURUS settled behind rivals, saved ground while rallying on the second turn, angled out three or four wide for the final sixteenth and offered a mild gain. ALY'S ALLEY gained the lead near the inside early, made the pace into the stretch but tired. TIJJYR (IRE) angled in early, was outrun until the stretch, came out eight wide for the drive but failed to respond. NORTHCOTE ROAD tracked the leaders four wide until nearing the stretch and tired. DAVID COPPERFIELD went up early to press front-running ALY'S ALLEY, held on well into the stretch, then while tiring, was checked at the sixteenth pole in tight quarters when THESAURUS angled out.
