Footnotes

MISS FORTUNATE tracked the pace from early on while three or four wide, inched to challenge entering the upper stretch, took over leaving the eighth pole and drove clear. TEMPUS FUGIT gained the lead early, worked her way in to race three wide, held a slight advantage while dueling with CLEAR DESTINY, moved clear on the far turn but couldn't handle the winner in the drive. JOYFUL BALLAD, near the inside and never far back, moved between rivals nearing the final quarter, loomed a solid threat five wide into the final furlong and lacked a late response. CLEAR DESTINY vied or the lead inside of TEMPUS FUGIT for nearly six furlongs, continued inside and held her position while unable to threaten. MEET ME AT MIDNITE, outrun early and four wide, came out seven wide for the drive and improved position while unable to menace. LAKE KINNERET, three or four wide, had no rally. GAMBLE TO VICTORY hopped slightly at the start, was checked between foes approaching the first turn, recovered to race within easy striking distance in behind horses until the stretch and faded.
