Footnotes

SEEK A STAR vied for the lead at once, raced outside HOT STORM while dueling four wide, was headed by that one entering the turn, regained a narrow margin, put away ASPEN TREE, then shook off HOT STORM leaving the eighth pole and drove clear under strong handling. COOL SPELL, reserved early, raced in behind horses, angled out five or six wide for the drive and finished well. HOT STORM exchanged bumps with ASPEN TREE after the start, went up to contest the pace inside of SEEK A STAR, headed that one entering the turn, battled on with that one into the final furlong and weakened. CULINARY, never far back and between foes four wide early, continued four or five wide, had aim in the drive and failed to fire. ASPEN TREE leaned in at the start exchanging bumps with HOT STORM, was nicely placed near the inside between foes, angled near the rail on the turn, moved menacingly four wide into the lane and flattened out. KOTA, outrun for five furlongs while three or four wide, made a mild run to reach contention at the furlong grounds and lacked a further response. SHE'S THAT CAT, forwardly placed between horses on the backstretch, weakened gradually on the turn. PUNCH APPEAL, up close five wide for nearly a half, weakened thereafter. OUR KES (IRE) angled near the inside midway on the backstretch and faded early on the turn.
