Footnotes

ALOTOFAPPEAL contested the pace between foes early, gained a slight edge, exchanged brushes in the upper stretch with CHANGE UP, then was bumped soundly approaching the wire by that one when proving gamely best under pressure. CHANGE UP, up close near the inside between foes early, appeared to tighten it up on LUNARLADY leaving the backstretch, raced inside on the turn while dueling with the winner, exchanged brushes with ALOTOFAPPEAL in the upper stretch, came out and bumped that foe approaching the wire and was outfinished. NATALICAT, bumped at the start and outrun early, came out six or seven wide for the drive and offered a mild gain. EXPERTISE drifted in at the start bumping NATALICAT, was never far back, raced four wide but was empty late. GOLD MINX, outrun five wide to the lane, continued five wide and improved position. DISTINCTIVE GOLD raced forwardly five or six wide to the stretch and tired. CRIMSON WHISPER was outrun. LUNARLADY, up close along the inside early, was forced to take up in tight quarter about the seven-sixteenths pole and couldn't recover. A FOUL CLAIM LODGED BY THE RIDER OF CHANGE UP AGAINST THE WINNER FOR ALLEGED INTERFERENCE IN THE STRETCH WAS DISALLOWED.
