Footnotes

GOULDINGS GREEN, reserved in behind the leaders early while three wide, eased out four abreast entering the far turn to secure room, inched to challenge entering the upper stretch, then outgamed WILD DESERT under strong handling. WILD DESERT, close up in hand three or four wide early, moved to challenge pacesetter CHIPPEWA TRAIL approaching the stretch, took over leaving the five-sixteenths pole, was engaged soon after by GOULDING GREEN from the outside entering the upper stretch, then was outfinished by that one in a long drive. ANDROMEDA'S HERO, unhurried while outrun into the backstretch three or four wide, edged closer midway on the far turn, came to the extreme outside to be eight wide for the drive, made a serious run outside the top two entering the final eighth but couldn't sustain the needed momentum. M B SEA leaned in at the start bumping GREATER GOOD, was outrun for a half while near the inside, came out between horses entering the upper stretch, reached a striking position at the furlong grounds but lacked a further account. SEEK GOLD was unhurried early and raced four wide, raced within easy striking distance into the far turn, remained prominent into the upper stretch, was steadied in tight at the eighth pole for several strides and flattened out. GREATER GOOD, bumped at the start by M B SEA, settled near the inside, eased out a bit approaching the stretch to be six wide but never fired. ARTEMUS SUNRISE gained the lead early, moved near the rail, surrendered the advantage to CHIPPEWA TRAIL early on the backstretch, continued in contention for six furlongs and tired. CHIPPEWA TRAIL, fractious in the gate prior to the start, bobbed at the break, went up soon after to force the pace three abreast, took over on the backstretch, opened a clear advantage, managed the lead for six furlongs and faded thereafter.
