TAKE THE RIBBON, lightly rated while tracking the leaders four wide, moved six wide into the lane and was fully extended to up in the last lunge. QUITE A BRIDE pressed front-running RICH FANTASY, took over from that one between calls in the final furlong, then was out-nodded on the wire. RICH FANTASY gained a clear advantage early, raced in the two path, made the pace into the final furlong and weakened. MAGNIFICENT SONG, reserved after the start, raced three wide, came out a bit farther on the course entering the upper stretch and failed to fire. CULPEPER MOON, a bit edgy in the gate prior to the start, raced near the inside and faded.
