EL CABALLO settled in hand, worked his way to the outside four wide, launched his bid entering the stretch, quickened late and caught SLEW THE MAN in the final yards. SLEW THE MAN was away alertly to set the pressured pace, bobbled a bit leaving the chute, angled in sharply to the rail, opened clear after a half, kept on well through a long drive but was unable to resist the winner. GLENWOOD CANYON tucked in to save ground while unhurried into stride, moved out and split rivals inside the three-sixteenths marker and was along in time to earn the show. MODERN COWBOY contended between horses, angled out five wide on the turn, offered a mild bid but failed to sustain the drive. OUR DARK KNIGHT was allowed to settle four wide and failed to respond. ANARKO (CHI) pressed the pace two wide, but faltered between horses entering the stretch and dropped out. GIANT CHIEFTAN saved ground to no avail.
