MR. TICKET disputed the pace three wide, opened clear leaving the turn, gamely met the bid of DYNAMICAL with a furlong to run and was fully extended to prevail. DYNAMICAL settled in hand, ranged up four wide through the turn, loomed large entering the stretch, drew even but was unable to best the determined winner. Z CAMELOT was slow into stride, swung to the outside, finished with good late run but was unable to reach the top two. NICKLAUS WAY was allowed to settle, moved up between horses to make a mild bid but failed to sustain the drive. PARABELLUM stumbled badly at the start, rushed up along the inside, continued the advance between horses through the turn, angled out five wide entering the stretch but weakened during the drive. FLAPSUP prompted the pace between horses through the turn and tired. KID FLATTER settled four wide and failed to respond. PROUD WARRIOR showed little. GRAND CONTENDER vied for the lead along the inside, came up empty after six furlongs and dropped out. COURTROOM DRAMA was through after a half.
