### Footnotes

STRAIGHT MAN drifted out a bit at the start while gaining a narrow advantage, raced four or five wide while dueling with KIMBERLITE PIPE from the inside, shook off that one, then, under strong handling, gamely held MULA GULA safe. The latter, within striking distance, moved inside, made a bold run from the rail nearing the final furlong, loomed inside the winner the remainder and hung. PATIENCE GAME, outsprinted early, saved ground until the stretch, circled foes seven wide, reached easy striking distance, but lacked a further response. KIMBERLITE PIPE went up early to vie for the lead outside of STRAIGHT MAN, battled with that one until the stretch and weakened. RUN JOHNNY, within striking distance and five or six wide throughout, lacked a closing bid. SON OF A PISTOL, forwardly placed between horses from the start, continued within easy striking distance in behind the leaders into the stretch and came up empty. YES IT'S TRUE, close up inside early, gave way readily concluding the turn.
