Footnotes

RUBY SURPRISE broke a step slowly, angled to the outside along the backstretch, made a three wide move leaving the far turn, drew alongside the leader to challenge approaching the top of the stretch, took charge in midstretch then held sway under intermittent left hand urging. HONEST LADY dropped back soon after the start, trailed for a half while saving ground, split horses to launch her bid on the turn, drifted out in upper stretch then finished well from outside to best the others. CASSIDY forced the pace while three wide along the backstretch, dropped back a bit on the turn, remained a factor into upper stretch and weakened in the final eighth. SWINGIN ON ICE outsprinted rivals for the early advantage, set the pace along the inside for a half, relinquished the lead to the winner leaving the turn, continued on well into midstretch then tired. FRENCH BRAIDS was unhurried early, raced well back while four wide on the turn and lacked the needed response when called upon. SWEEPING STORY chased the leader between horses along the backstretch, fell back while saving ground on the turn and steadily tired thereafter. ZUPPARDO ARDO was unable to keep the early pace while four wide, was carried six wide leaving the turn then gave way.
