**Footnotes**

ZAPPARITION close up along the inside, moved up along the rail on the second turn, angled out for the drive carrying SHEZA SWEET LEMON out a bit, challenged between rivals approaching the furlong marker and drew clear under steady urging. LEDA within striking distance three wide, moved out a path late on the second turn, challenged once in the stretch and held on for the place. RAILLERY bumped at the start, was reserved along the inside, saved ground on the second turn and into the stretch, angled out with a furlong to go but lodged only a mild late bid. MINTS N THE VALLEY set the pace along the inside, held on well to midstretch and tired. SENSATIONAL BREW drifted out at the start and bumped RAILLERY, was reserved three wide and lacked a rally. SHEZA SWEET LEMON forwardly placed off the inside, gained the rail for the second turn, angled out a bit for the drive, was carried out a bit by the winner once in the stretch and tired. MS LAW closest to the pace three wide, held on well to the stretch and faded. ADORABELLA was outrun. SINFUL STATE forwardly placed off the rail, faded.
