Footnotes

SMOOTH CHARM prompted the pace two to three wide outside VIRTUOUSLY while under a snug hold, moved on near even terms after a half mile, took over leaving the five sixteenth pole, responded when roused in upper stretch and pulled away late under solid right handed encouragement. EMPRESS OF GOLD , a bit rank into the backstretch while two wide behind foes, tracked the leaders into the far turn, worked between rivals past the eighth pole and finished gamely inside TROPIC OF AQUARIUS to edge that one for the place. TROPIC OF AQUARIUS angled out mid way on the first turn, stalked the pace three to four wide, moved a bit closer mid way on the final turn, continued on willingly but was edged for the place. VIRTUOUSLY grabbed command at once, set a moderate pace towards the inside, took pressure down the backstretch, dueled inside the winner leaving the far turn, held well to mid stretch then faded. EXPRESSO RUN was angled in to the three path early, remained well off the rail throughout and lacked a response. RESERVED INDIAN was pushed out four wide mid way on the first turn, settled in a striking position three to four wide down the backstretch, was called on for her best leaving the far turn, failed to respond and faded in the drive. ISLAND BOUND settled back inside, was put to a drive near the three eighths pole and had no kick.
