Footnotes

PLUM PRETTY lost her footing at the start, tracked the pace while in hand, reeled in the leader on the second turn, challenged with less than three furlongs

to go, drew off into the stretch and lasted late. ST. JOHN'S RIVER hit the side of the starting gate stall when breaking awkwardly, swerved to the rail soon after, advanced in the two path on the second turn, moved to the rail in upper stretch, steadily moved up on the leader inside the final furlong, angled out with a sixteenth to go and was gaining rapidly late. ZAZU steadied entering the first turn in traffic, was outrun for six furlongs, angled out six wide entering the stretch when rallying and made a good late gain. JOYFUL VICTORY steadied entering the first turn in traffic, recovered to race within striking distance off the inside, waited between rivals on the second turn, angled out a bit for the drive but lodged only a mild late bid. BOUQUET BOOTH within reach of the leaders four wide, came five wide into the stretch and made a late gain. KATHMANBLU within striking distance off the rail, waited briefly approaching the stretch then tired in the drive. DAISY DEVINE close up three wide, moved out a path on the second turn, held on well to the stretch and gave way. STREET STORM far back early while off the rail, moved out five wide on the second turn, angled out for the drive but could not threaten. SUAVE VOIR FAIRE unhurried along the inside, raced in the four path on the second turn and could not menace. SUMMER SOIREE sprinted clear, set the pace off the inside but gave way readily when headed. HER SMILE rated three wide the opening half, faded. LILACS AND LACE close up along the inside, stopped suddenly midway through the second turn. HOLY HEAVENS out sprinted early five wide, moved seven wide into the stretch and was no factor.
