CHALICE reserved for a half, made a good middle m9ove off the rail, was in tight when challenging in upper stretch, angled out and closed well to be up in time. OUR NOBLE HEART bobbled at the start, quickly moved closest to the pace while in hand, was carried out entering the stretch when moving to challenge, drifted in in midstretch after assuming a short lead, battled the remainder but was outfinished. MINISTER COLIN ducked in at the start and bumped NUMEN LUMEN, steadied behind rivals late on the first turn, moved up inside after a half, came out between rivals entering the stretch to challenge and held on gamely to miss.; MR. JEEVES within striking distance three wide, was carried out entering the stretch, drifted in with three sixteenths to go bothering GOLD TRADER then hung. GOLD TRADER unhurried along the inside, made a good middle move, swerved out entering the stretch, steadied when MR JEEVES drifted in soon after then made a solid late gain. TAPAWAY within striking distance off the rail, angled out to advance on the second turn, clipped MR JEEVES heels when that one was carried out entering the stretch, swerved out then made a late gain. PARCEL outrun for a half, found his best stride late. BRILLIANT VISION behind the leaders, saved ground on the second turn and lacked a late bid. NUMEN LUMEN bumped at the start, set the pace, drifted out entering the stretch carrying several rivals out, was carried back in by OUR NOBLE HEART soon after then tired. SUN BEAR outbroke his rider and was outrun. CRYPTO PETE unhurried early, was carried extremely wide entering the stretch and was no factor. A FOUL CLAIM BY THE RIDER

OF TAPAWAY AGAINST THE RIDER OF CHALICE FOR INTERFERENCE IN THE STRETCH WAS NOT ALLOWED.
