FOR THREE YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD. By subscription of \$300 each, which should accompany the nomination or by Supplementary Nomination of \$15,000 at time of entry. \$1,500 to pass the entry box; \$1,500 additional to start, with \$300,000 added. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 62% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weights: Three-year-olds 117 lbs.; Older 123 lbs. Non-winners of a Grade I or II stakes at a mile or over since September 6, allowed 2 lbs.; \$60,000 twice at a mile or over since December 6, 4 lbs.; \$60,000 at a mile or over in 2011, 6 lbs. Starters to be named through the entry box at the usual time of closing. All supplementary nominations will be required to pay entry and starting fees if they participate. Trophy to winning owner. Closed Wednesday, April 13, 2011 with 45 nominations.

FIRST DUDE settled into a good position while four wide, commenced his run leaving the three eighths pole, circled five wide under a ride into the lane, closed determinedly under brisk right handed shoulder whipping and nipped REGAL RANSOM at the wire. REGAL RANSOM rated kindly two to three wide off of WISE DAN, moved in hand to challenge past the five sixteenths marker, forged to command in upper stretch, battled gamely on a tenuous advantage past the sixteenth pole then just lost the nose bob in a sharp effort. EQUESTRIO saved ground while not far back, angled four wide advancing into the stretch, rallied between rivals inside the eighth pole and stayed on well. AWESOME GEM settled two to three wide, worked his way out to the seven path past the eighth pole and finished up well between horses to steadily gain. GIANT OAK, unhurried four wide while well off the early pace, was put to a ride nearing the quarter pole, shifted out eight wide inside the eighth pole and found his best too late. CARACORTADO rated off the pace in the two path, was called on for run three furlongs out, made a solid run between rivals to challenge in mid stretch, dueled inside REGAL RANSOM past the sixteenth marker then flattened out. MISSION IMPAZIBLE, forwardly placed three wide, moved up slightly while under a ride nearing the lane, shifted out some in mid stretch, failed to sustain and gave way. WISE DAN cleared early, set a moderate pace along the inside, was collared nearing the quarter pole, gave little resistance past the three sixteenths marker and weakened. DEMARCATION was kept well wide throughout and never menaced.
